1819 89 Public Bodies (Admissions to Meetings) Act 1960 amended by Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014

1819 90 Public Open Session

1819 91 To accept apologies for absence

Lack of parking spaces in Holmfirth – a resident has suggested that the Parish Council should approach the new owners of a local business to ask them to consider demolishing the building and converting the whole site into a public car park.

RESOLVED: That the resident be advised to contact Kirklees Council who are responsible for car parking in the area.

The Locum Clerk provided an update on the reported Public Rights of Way Problems. Local support groups may be able to help clearing some paths, other authorities support tool and equipment banks for the volunteers.

RESOLVED: That the Locum Clerk pass onto Kirklees Council details of paths that were blocked or had no signage. Councillor Cropper will investigate what support groups are available and the Locum Clerk will contact neighbouring council to investigate equipment loaning schemes.
