SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE COUNCIL

Allotments

There are six allotment sites located in Holme Village.

There is currently a waiting list for these allotments; to be placed on the waiting list, contact the Clerk.

Closed Churchyard

The Council is responsible for maintenance of the closed churchyard area at Christ Church, New Mill. Appropriate maintenance works are carried out in agreement with the Parochial Church Council.

Public Seats

The Council provides and maintains public seats situated on highways, footways, and adjacent to public footpaths; there are some 133 seats. The Council also looks after some memorial seats.

Seats in recreation grounds are provided and maintained by Kirklees Council.

War Memorials

The following War Memorials are vested in the Council:

Brockholes – j/o of Oakes Lane and Station Road, Brockholes

Honley – grounds of cemetery, Green Cliffe, Honley

Netherthong – j/o of New Road, Thong Lane and Meltham Road, Netherthong.

It has also undertaken maintenance works at the following:

Hepworth – lychgates at Hepworth Parish Church

Holmbridge – grounds of St David's Church, Holmbridge

Holme Valley Memorial Hospital – grounds

Upperthong – lychgates at St John's Church, Upperthong

Bus Shelters/other shelters

The Council has recently transferred to WYPTE ownership and responsibility for all cantilever bus shelters in the Holme Valley, but retains ownership and responsibility for maintenance of stone shelters, not all of which are used as bus shelters. There are 25 such stone shelters in the Holme Valley. Further details can be obtained from the Clerk.
