

The Hall roof had been leaking for several years in different places. Despite several previous repairs leaks continued to appear. A full survey revealed that the roof felt was rotten and needed to be replaced. The felt was of a type that is no longer used due to this issue.


The committee obtained 3 quotes for the work and selected Parker Maythorn Ltd due to their expertise, experience in reroofing buildings of this type and their competitive quote.

The work was delayed due to contractor availability and poor weather. The work below was completed in December 2024 as notified to Parish Council office on the 14th of January 2025.

Work completed:

- Supply and fix access scaffold and safety equipment
- Strip stone slate roof and store for re use
- Clean timber work & check condition
- New timber work to collapsed ridge line
- Felting roof with breathable membrane (BS5534)
- Re lathing using tantalized laths fixed with galvanized nails
- Re slating using existing slates, fix with aluminum slater pegs
- 3.8 tonnes of good second-hand slates to replace broken ones
- Fix ridge with sand and cement mortar
- Re-boarding and installation of rubber membrane to area behind building headstone
- Lead work around chimneys and gable ends
- Stripping scaffolding and cleaning site

What you achieved			
What were the benefits of your project? (Maximum 500 words)	The Hall is now water type protecting the building and its use for the future. Without this work the hire of the Hall would have become difficult, leading to reduced income and putting the security of the Hall at risk. The cost of the re-roofing has however meant that other projects including replacing toilet and kitchen facilities have had to be put on hold until further funds can be secured.

Our annual free Christmas Carol concert is a fabulous, well attended community event for all ages.
