Honley Open Gardens took place over the weekend of 7th and 8th June 2025. It attracted over 750 visitors which was good when the poor weather was taken into consideration. The grant awarded was used to pay for mini buses to take our visitors to the outer gardens so they did not use cars, so making it more environmentally advantages.

We had to book a last minute mini bus from Huddersfield because one of the scouts buses failed its MOT. We also increased the numbers of buses to 5 for Sunday so people

would not be waiting more than 15 mins at any stop.
The event was very successful making a profit of around £7.5k which is already being allocated against the library landscaping of up to a max £3k plus £1.5k for a planting project near the car park in the centre of Honley. Plus planting tubs, railing planters and tyres all around the village to ensure Honley looks loved.
