| Purpose for which the grant was awarded (Maximum 20 words) | To enable young people of the community to access coaching staff required to support the participation in a countrywide Netball event. The event organised by Leeds Rhinos saw over 80 teams from all over the U.K. participating in a Netball Weekender. The event stipulated that all attendees were booked through the ESF events organisers which therefore required a significant cost commitment for our coaches to attend making the event possible for over 40 junior players from the local area. |

Our club organised a netball residential trip for 44 girls and their parents. The girls took part in the Leeds Rhino Challenge Netball Weekender at Butlins, Skegness. Six of our coaches also attended the weekend which consisted of two days of netball. We used the grant money to pay for the coaches' accommodation and expenses. It was essential

that coaches were present for this weekend so that we could provide our players with high level coaching, match planning and tactical instruction. It is critical that we had coaches trained to lead the teams, deal with any safeguarding concerns or first aid incidents.

The coaches travelled in two cars and were given money for their travel expenses. They arrived on the Friday evening and settled into their accommodation before attending a Leeds Rhinos coaches meeting to explain the format of the weekend and then met up with the girls to plan Saturday.

On Saturday morning, the coaches were up early to attend the first matches of the day. We took four teams so each team had one dedicated coach with two coaches floating between teams. Having floating coaches allowed them to deal with any issues which arose. Unfortunately, we had a few players injured so the floating coaches were able to give the girls the care and attention that they needed whilst the other coaches were able to continue coaching the rest of the teams.

When the netball had finished on the first day, the coaches spent some time with the players and their families. They enjoyed getting to know the girls more in a social setting and had fun at the fair. The coaches also spent time with the parents in the evening.

On the second day the coaches led the teams to compete in the final tournament fixtures and attended an inspirational awards ceremony presented by a famous Leeds Rhinos & England netball player. Without the coaches the event would not be possible, their role was critical to ensure we were able to provide this amazing opportunity to the girls.

What you achieved

What were the benefits of your project? (Maximum 500 words)

This year was the first year that we had organised a weekend away for our junior players and it was a massive success. Without the grant to support our coaches' attendance the weekend would not have been possible.

The weekend away made many of our players step outside their comfort zone and gave them the confidence to try new things, on and off the netball court. The numerous engaging activities boosted the club's morale and created positive memories for everyone who went to Butlins.

For the players, it gave them a chance to enhance their bonds with their teammates and other players from different teams. Our older players, who often don't see the younger players as they train on different evenings, were able to spend time with the younger girls which was lovely to see. The players spent their free time socializing in groups at the parks and funfair on site. On the Saturday evening, the girls persuaded the coaches to join them at the fair and they had a brilliant time on the rides. There was plenty of laughter, noise and fun!

During the day, the girls played netball at a local high school which was a great experience for them as they were competing against new teams with different playing styles. They coped well with playing in a new environment and enjoyed their netball even in the cold, damp weather. The

| | netball played over the weekend helped to develop the players' skills as they were coached every game and improved throughout the tournament. The trip away also enabled the parents and carers to create new friendships and strengthen existing bonds. Many adults spoke about how nice it was to be able spend more time with other parents instead of just talking to them on the sideline at a match. |
